

AL-77 Coosa River Bridge Replacement

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to replace the bridge on AL-77 over the Coosa River near Southside, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **July 5, 2024**.



Project Description

The proposed project will replace the existing Northbound bridge on AL-77 over the Coosa River. The bridge, which is located between the towns of Rainbow City and Southside is a one-lane historic truss bridge with limited lane width and narrow shoulders. ALDOT proposes to replace the existing bridge with a new bridge that will have two 12-foot lanes, and minimum 6-foot shoulders. The new bridge would be built higher than the existing bridge. Alternatives, as well as traffic control for the bridge replacement, are under consideration. Right of way will be required.
