

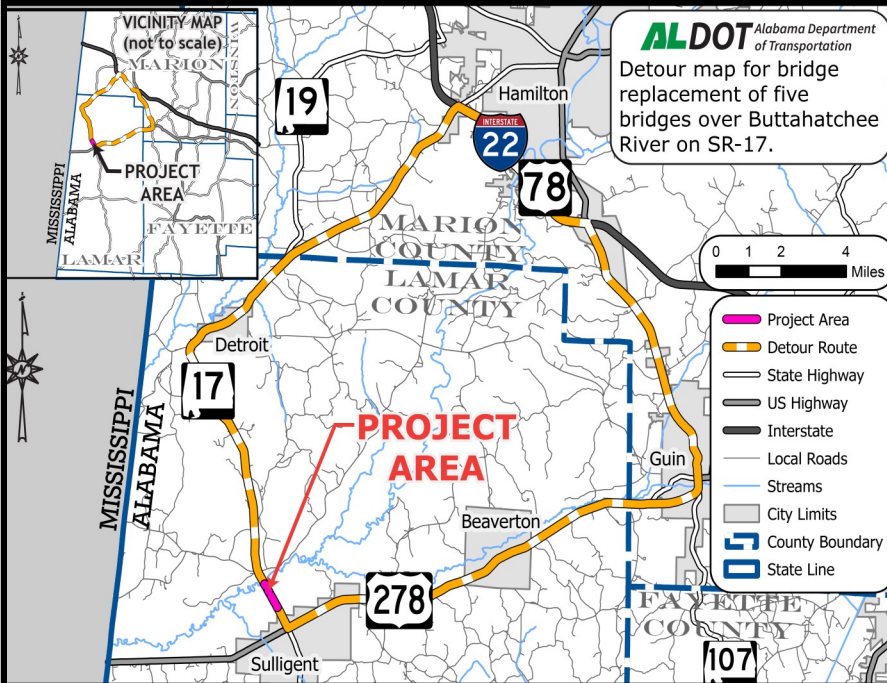

Bridge Replacements on AL-17 Over Buttahatchee River and 4 Relief Bridges

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing bridge replacements over Buttahatchee River and 4 relief bridges along AL-17 in Lamar County. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **October 9, 2026**.



Project Description

The purpose of this project is to replace address aging infrastructure and function deficiencies of the existing bridges. The bridges were constructed in 1941 and no longer meet current design standards due to the narrow width of the existing bridges.

The new bridges will provide 12-ft travel lanes with 8-ft shoulders.

The construction of these bridges will require an off-site detour around the project. A recommended detour will be signed to include AL-17, I-22 (US-78), and AL-74 (US-278).
