| 4.  | <b><u>Job Acceptance Requirements:</u></b> No Job Control samples required if material works satisfactorily. Material must be from this approved list. | 5.  | <b><u>Project Engineer's Responsibility:</u></b> Check and assure that the materials are on the approved list.  | 8.   | <b><u>Laboratory Testing:</u></b> The Department will check all data submitted for the product to assure compliance with the Department's Specifications.   |
| 5.1 | Furnish certified test reports covering both metal and coating for corrugated metal pipe to the Certification Section of the Central Laboratory.  | 9.   | <b><u>Contractors' Requirements:</u></b> The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.  |
