LIST III-2

PATCHING MATERIALS FOR PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE

1. Material: Patching materials for Portland Cement Concrete pavement, bridge decks and for other horizontal, vertical and overhead applications.
2. Specification: None
3. Jurisdiction: Product Evaluation Board, Product Evaluation Engineer
4. Job Acceptance Requirements: The Department does not allow the use of this material on new construction without prior approval from the Construction Bureau. Primarily used for maintenance. No job control samples necessary if the product works satisfactorily.
5. Project Engineer's Responsibility: Check and assure that the materials are on the approved list, and that they have been approved for use on the project.
 - 5.1 Verify that the shelf life of the material has not been exceeded and that the material is in good condition.
 - 5.2 Verify that the material is blended in the correct proportions and mixed to a consistent blend.
 - 5.3 Prohibit the use of material that has exceeded its pot life.
6. Producer's Initial Requirements: Companies seeking to have products evaluated for placement on this list must contact AASHTO Product Evaluation & Audit Solutions (formerly National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP)):

After the product is evaluated by AASHTO and results printed on the report, the company must furnish the Department's Product Evaluation Engineer the following:
A written request to place the product on the list. The request must include the number for the most recent evaluation of the product. Only evaluations from the previous 5 years will be accepted.
New Product Evaluation Form & fees, in a Accordance with ALDOT-355.
7. Producer's Maintenance Requirements: Companies with products on this list will be expected to comply with the following to stay on the list:
 - 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
 - 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
 - 7.3 Promptly report to the Department any changes to the company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
 - 7.4 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the performance of the product will require a reevaluation of the product.
 - 7.5 All products that require testing shall submit to AASHTO Product Evaluation & Audit Solutions for re-evaluation on a 5-year cycle.
 - 7.6 Promptly report to the Department any changes to the manufacturer's Build America, Buy America (BABA) compliant status.
8. Field Testing: None
9. Contractors' Requirements: The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
10. Removal of Products: Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
 - 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of Products other than those originally submitted.
 - 10.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
 - 10.3 Failure to work satisfactorily on the job.
 - 10.4 A change that will affect the manufacturer's BABA status requirement(s) will result in either (1) the product being removed from the approval list or (2) will remain on the approval list and will be labeled as non-compliant and can be used on non-federal funded projects.
